



97TH Indianapolis 500 Entry Filed for 1996 Winner Lazier



Lazier Partners Racing adds 34th entry to 2013 field

INDIANAPOLIS, Wednesday, May 8, 2013 - Lazier Partners Racing filed an entry for the 97th Indianapolis 500, with 1996 Indianapolis 500 winner Buddy Lazier listed as the driver.

The entry adds a fourth winner of "The Greatest

Spectacle in Racing" to the potential starting field, as Lazier joins three-time winners Dario Franchitti and Helio Castroneves and 2008 winner Scott Dixon.

Lazier Partners' entry was the 34th for this year's race, which will breed competition for the 33 starting spots during Pole Day qualifying Saturday, May 18 and Old National Armed Forces Bump Day qualifying Sunday, May 19.

The 97th Indianapolis 500 is scheduled to start at noon (ET) Sunday, May 26. ESPN on ABC, the IMS Radio Network and SiriusXM 211 will begin their live broadcasts at 11 a.m.

Lazier, from Vail, Colo., will drive the No. 91 Lazier Partners Dallara/Chevrolet/Firestone. No backup car was entered. The team owner is Lazier's father, 1981 Indianapolis 500 veteran Bob Lazier.

2000 IZOD IndyCar Series champion Lazier last raced in the "500" in 2008, qualifying 32nd and finishing 17th in a Hemelgarn Johnson Racing entry. He failed to qualify in 2009.

Lazier, 45, becomes the senior driver in this year's field in age and experience. He has made 16 previous starts at Indianapolis, with five top-five finishes. Lazier produced five consecutive top-seven finishes from 1996-2000, including the victory in 1996 and runner-up finishes in 1998 and 2000.

Dates Set For GRAND-AM, ALMS, IMSA Awards

GRAND-AM Road Racing, the American Le Mans Series (ALMS) presented by Tequila Patrón and the International Motor Sports Association (IMSA) today announced plans for postseason awards celebrations that will wrap up 2013 while setting the stage for their 2014 merger and the inaugural United SportsCar Racing season.

Here's the lineup:

- The Continental Tire Sports Car Challenge Awards will be held on Saturday, Sept. 28 at Lime Rock Park in Lakeville, Conn., following GRAND-AM's season finale weekend at the storied road course.
- The GRAND-AM Rolex Sports Car Series Awards will return to New York City's Gotham Hall on the evening of Monday, Sept. 30. The InterContinental New York Times Square will again serve as the official hotel for the Rolex Series Awards.
- Competitors in the IMSA GT3 Cup Challenge by Yokohama and the Cooper Tires Prototype Lites Championship will be recognized during separate special events at Road Atlanta in Braselton, Ga., on Friday. Oct. 18
- · And on Sunday, Oct. 20, the American Le Mans Series Presented by Tequila Patrón Night of Champions Awards will be at Château Élan in Braselton, Ga., one night after the ALMS' season-ending Petit Le Mans powered by Mazda 10-hour endurance classic.

"Last year's Rolex Series Awards at Gotham Hall really gave the drivers, teams, tracks, manufacturers and sponsors involved in the Rolex Series a premium setting to showcase their efforts," said GRAND-AM President and CEO Ed Bennett. "Now it's time for another showcase, one that will celebrate 2013 but also set the table for what is sure to be a landmark 2014 season."

ALMS President and CEO Scott Atherton envisions "a special significance to this year's Night of Champions for the American Le Mans Series presented by Tequila Patrón. As we look forward with great anticipation to a new era starting in 2014, we'll also celebrate 15 seasons of countless memorable events and so many great champions of the ALMS. It truly will be a celebration to remember."


